




Data Source: The land-water data were obtained from digital imagery (Z/I Imaging digital mapping camera) with 1-meter resolution, acquired October-November 2005. All areas characterized by emergent vegetation, Louisiana Department of Natural Resources upland, wetland forest, or scrub-shrub were classified as land, while open water, aquatic beds, and mudflats were classified as water.





The DCA includes field samplings of water level, salinity, vegetation, change, and soils.
