5. Work Description - Start, Finish, Progress, Etc.:

7/10/07 - 8/15/07:

A pre-construction conference was held on 7/10/07 at the Lafayette District office of LA DNR/CED to discuss the scope of the project, responsibilities of all parties involved, time schedule and sequence of construction, and coordination of construction inspection activities. Representatives from LA DNR/CED, Luhr Bros., Weeks Marine, and A&A were in attendance at this meeting. The contractor was given the Notice to Proceed on 6/6/07, and began construction on 8/3/07. During this time period, Weeks Marine mobilized the dredge barge to excavate the flotation channel. The Flotation Excavation was completed on 8/11/07 and the Warning Sign Installation was completed on 8/15/07.

<u>8/16/07 - 9/27/07</u>:

A construction conference was held on 8/16/07 at the Lafayette District office of LA DNR/CED to discuss Bertucci's responsibilities related to the project. Representatives from LA DNR/CED, Luhr Bros., Bertucci, and A&A were in attendance at this meeting. During this time period, Bertucci mobilized (8/27/07) the rock barges, one (1) barge mounted crane, and (1) track excavator to begin the rock dike construction, rock weir construction, and placement of paving stone with geotextile fabric at ends of the rock dike and rock weirs. The contractor completed construction on 9/27/07 and LA DNR/CED accepted the project as substantially complete on that date. Following acceptance, the contractor demobilized all equipment from the project site.

6. Modifications and Changes:

There were very minor overruns to the original plan quantities for the riprap. However, the contractor agreed to compensation for the original plan quantities.

7. Quality Control:

Quality control was administered by the contractor (Weeks Marine and Bertucci) and the project engineer (A&A). All reports were compiled by A&A and weekly updates were emailed to LA DNR/CED throughout the duration of the project.

8. Environmental:

The contractor's concern towards environmental quality control was satisfactory. No reports were needed for the project. The contractor made every effort to make no adverse environmental impact on the area.

9. Safety/Accidents:

No accidents occurred for the duration of the project.

10. Final Acceptance:

A final inspection of the project was conducted on September 26, 2007, by Herbert Juneau, Garrett Broussard and Stan Aucoin of LA DNR/CED; Dale Garber of NRCS; and Benny Ortego of A&A. The project was accepted as substantially complete on September 27, 2007.
