
## APPENDIX A SURVEY CONTROL BENCHMARKS

Station Name: "RONQUILLE 2"

Monument Location: The Station is located in Section 16, T21S-R27E, Plaquemines, Parish, Louisiana. The Station can be reached by boat from Grand Isle, Louisiana, or Empire, Louisiana. It is located on the westerly high spoil band at the southerly end of a well canal, and is approximately midway between Chaland Pass and Bayou Huertes on the north side of a pipeline canal and 1 foot from an orange carsonite witness post. The old station "CHENIER RONQUILLE" has been destroyed, but the bent over deep driven rod is still present at the site.

**Monument Description:** Stainless steel rod driven to refusal within a sleeve and protective cover set in concrete and stamped "RONQUILLE 2 - 2005".
