
Dear Mr. Kinler:

The Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality, Water Permits Division (LDEQ), has reviewed the application to excavate and place fill along the south shore of Grand Land in the vicinity of Tebo Point, Cameron Parish.

The information provided in the application and the additional information received October 31, 2014, has been reviewed in terms of compliance with State Water Quality Standards, the approved Water Quality Management Plan and applicable state water laws, rules and regulations. LDEQ determined that the requirements for a Water Quality Certification have been met. LDEQ concludes the excavation and discharge of fill material will not violate water quality standards as provided for in LAC 33:IX.Chapter 11. Therefore, LDEQ hereby issues Cameron Parish Police Jury Water Quality Certification, WQC 140602-01.
