**I. Responses to Questions Submitted by Contractors:**

Contractor Question/Comment (1): The bid form requires separate pricing for the Wills Point and Alliance borrow areas in both Alternates 1 and 2 (Mobilization/Demobilization and Hydraulic Dredging). This bid format implies that both of these areas are not available for Contractor's use during construction of the Base bid elements of work.

- a. Can Wills Point borrow area be used in construction of the Base Bid?
- b. We recommend the bid form for both Alternates 1 and 2 be structured same as the Base Bid, that is, do not require separate pricing for both borrow areas. This enables the planning and managed use of the borrow areas be left to the discretion of the Contractor.

CPR A Response (1): The following clarification and amendment is made to the bid form and plans.

- a. Yes, Wills Point borrow area may be used in construction of the base bid.
- b. Alternates 1 and 2 are revised to be structured the same as the base bid with a single mobilization/demobilization and hydraulic dredging item for each. These changes are reflected in the revised Unit Price Bid form (see attached) and revised Sheet 2 of 81(see attached). It is hoped this increased flexibility will enable the Contractor efficiencies in planning and management as stated that will be reflected in the bid pricing.

Contractor Question/Comment (2): We request reasonable payment terms be incorporated into the contract. Payment within 30 days or less of submission of progress invoice is standard form for construction contracts, and is reasonable for inclusion in this contract.

CPR A Response (2): The State makes every attempt to pay invoices in a timely manner.

Contractor Question/Comment (3): Reference General Provisions GP-59. This clause stipulates that 5% shall be reserved from any payments due Contractor until 45 days after final acceptance.

- a. Please consider substituting this reserve amount with a bond or other form of guarantee such as a Letter of Credit?
- b. We request a reasonable cap be placed on the max reserve amount retained. We suggest \$2.5M as a reasonable maximum retainage amount.

CPR A Response (3): The terms outlined in GP-59 remain as stated.

In the event of material underruns/overruns by less than twenty-five percent (25%), the bid unit costs will be used to determine payment to the contractor. If the actual quantity of the unit-priced item varies more than 25 percent above or below the estimated quantity, an equitable adjustment in the contract price shall be made upon demand of either party."*
