II. PROJECT MANUAL:

1. SP 2.1: The last sentence of this section shall be revised as follows:

A special use permit (SUP) is required to access the Project Site and shall obtained by the Contractor prior to project commencement.

2. TS 200.4: Replace with the following language:

Magnetometer surveys will not be required.

3. TS 370.3: The following language shall be added to the end of this section:

Spoil material generated from the installation of the tidal creeks shall be side casted and wasted on each side of the tidal creek, or on a single side, as directed by the Engineer. The spoil material shall not be placed adjacent to the perimeter of the tidal creeks or create obstructions along the alignment of the tidal creeks.












Goose Point/Point Platte (PO-0033) and Bayou Bonfouca (PO-0104) Tidal Creek Typical Section




Goose Point/Point Platte (PO-0033) and Bayou Bonfouca (PO-0104) Dike Gap Typical Section




