1. **Question:** The pipeline corridor for Marsh Area 4 is shown landing on the far west side of the island, in lieu of landing on the east side which is just north of the borrow area. Landing on the west side unnecessarily increases pipeline length. Please consider allowing contractors to land pipeline on the east side of Marsh Area 4.

**Response:** Due to the existence of three (3) offshore archeological sites which are located on the eastern side of Marsh Creation Area 4, Pipeline and Equipment Corridor 4 will remain at the location shown on Sheets 3 and 8 of the Plans.
