## INVITATION TO BID PELICAN ISLAND RESTORATION (BA38-1) CWPPRA PROJECT

Sealed bids for the construction of PELICAN ISLAND RESTORATION (BA38-1) CWPPRA PROJECT will be received at the office of THE GOVERNMENT until HH:00 on MMMM DD, YYYY. All bids will then be opened and bid prices read aloud. Sealed envelopes or packages containing bids shall be addressed to THE GOVERNMENT and shall be marked "Bid for Pelican Island Restoration (BA38-1) CWPPRA Project."

# **General Description of Work**

The Pelican Island Restoration (BA38-1) CWPPRA Project consists of the placement of approximately 957,600 cubic yards of marsh fill, 1,444,700 cubic yards of beach and dune fill, and 17,392 feet of containment dikeage along a 2.5 mile barrier island. It includes the construction of 206 acres of marshland on the bay side of the island and 163 acres of subaerial dunes and beaches on the gulf side of the island. The construction berm elevation on Pelican Island is +6 feet NAVD, the marsh platform elevation is +3 feet NAVD, the average marsh width is 680 feet, and the average subaerial dune and beach width is 540 feet. The construction of the marsh, dunes, and beaches will increase the average width of Pelican Island to approximately 1,200 feet. The slope of the beach and dune fill template is one (1) foot vertical to forty-five (45) feet horizontal along both the bay and gulf sides of the dune.

## **Contract Documents**

A copy of all Contract Documents is on file and available for inspection at THE GOVERNMENT.

Copies of the documents may be obtained upon payment of \$50 for each set of documents. Written requests should be addressed to THE GOVERNMENT.

# **Bid Security**

Each bid shall be accompanied by a bidder guaranty bond, certified or cashier's check or a satisfactory bid bond payable to THE GOVERNMENT in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the total amount of the bid as a guarantee that the bidder will within fifteen (15) days after the date of the award of a contract execute an agreement and file bonds and insurance as required by the Contract Documents if his bid is accepted.

If an intended awardee fails to execute and file an agreement, bonds, and insurance as required by the Contract Documents, the amount of the security submitted with his bond shall be forfeited as liquidated damages.

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# Federal and State Requirements

The attention of the bidder is directed to the applicable federal and state requirements and conditions of employment to be observed and minimum wage rates to be paid under the contract.

Before a contract is awarded, compliance with all EPA requirements specified in the Contract Documents will be subject to U.S. EPA review and approval.

# **Pre-Bid Conference and Site Visit**

A pre-bid conference and site visit for all prospective bidders will be held in THE GOVERNMENT on MMMM DD, YYYY at HH:00 local time at THE GOVERNMENT. A site visit will start at HH:00. Only those bidders who demonstrate compliance with OSHA health and safety training and medical surveillance requirements in 29 CFR 1910.120 will be allowed on site.

# Award of Contract

The right is reserved to reject any Bid or all Bids not conforming to the intent and purpose of the Contract Documents, to postpone the award of Contracts for a period of time which shall not exceed beyond ninety (90) days from the Bid opening date, and to accept the Bid which is in the best interest of THE GOVERNMENT.
