The Louisiana State Department of Environmental Quality has received an application for a proposal to implement the Gulf Intracoastal Waterway (GIWW) bank restoration of critical areas to protect fragile floating marsh to the south of GIWW and to stop shoreline erosion beginning near mile marker 80 and ending near mile marker 70 in Amelia, Terrebonne Parish, Louisiana.

The requirements for Water Quality Certification have been met in accordance with LAC 33:IX.1507.A-E. Based on the information provided in your application, we have determined that the placement of the fill material will not violate the water quality standards of Louisiana provided for under LAC 33:IX.Chapter 11.
