2. Location & Description of Project

The Bayou De Cade Ridge and Marsh Creation Project (TE-0138) is located within the Lake Mechant Sub-basin approximately eight (8) miles west of Theriot, La. in Terrebonne Parish, near the vicinity of Lake De Cade, and is bounded by Turtle Bayou and an existing oilfield location canal to the north and west, Bayou De cade to the south, and Lake De Cade to the east.

This project was part of the original construction to complete planting of the southern ridge. The project consisted of installing 373 Wax Myrtles, 373 Yaupon, and 373 French Mulberry trees.

9. Construction Change Orders and Field Changes.

Change Order No.:

Change Order No. 1: Increase contract days by 62 calendar days. This due to no work allowed prior to January 1st, 2023. Increase contract cost by \$16,955.56. Increase cost is due to the ridge needing to be cut prior to mobilization. This is from the over whelming growth of Roseau Cane.

Change Order No. 2: Increase contract days by 70 calendar days. Increase contract cost by \$3,775.33. This increased cost and days was to help maintain the growth of the Roseau Cane around the planting trees. After an inspection was conducted the Roseau Cane had started growing faster than anticipated from the cutting before planting. We also increased days to allow the optimal spraying time of the Roseau.

Change Order No. 3: increase contract days by 14 days. This was due to the miscalculation and change in weather patterns to allow the spraying of the Roseau Cane. This was a no cost change order.
